Beyond Good and Evil was Nietzsche's attempt to summarize his entire philosophy into one book. I don't know if I'd ever call anything Nietzsche wrote a summary, but this book does lay out his principles in black-and-white, and it did help me put some of the pieces together. After kicking open the doors to twentieth-century philosophy in *Thus Spoke Zarathustra*, Friedrich Nietzsche refined his ideal of the superman with the 1886 publication of *Beyond Good and Evil*. Conventional morality is a sign of slavery, Nietzsche maintains, and the superman goes beyond good and evil in action, thought, and creation. *Beyond Good and Evil* is one of the most remarkable and influential books of the nineteenth century.
