Primary Sources • Before and After the May Fourth Movement [Asia for Educators] The so-called "May Fourth" or "new culture" movement began in China around 1916, following the failure of the 1911 Revolution to establish a republican government, and continued through the 1920s. Reforms of the Early 19th Century. The Temperance Movement sought to end the increasingly common issue of excessive drinking. Due to the social customs of the time, alcoholism consumed many individuals, mainly men. Drinking was "a basic part of men's working lives". (Faragher, p.438) Toasts were routine at work and at social gatherings alike for men.
