

Download Guided Reading Activity 12 1 Answers

A number of questions and answers follow....Note: If small-group guided reading is a regular routine for your students, the introduction to thin and thick questions could be done in that setting. However, carrying out the following steps is also viable in a whole-group setting.

1. Let students know that they can ask questions for many ...Having piloted whole-class reading lessons in Year Four, our headteacher was keen to roll it out across the school. Currently, all of our Key Stage Two are now teaching reading like this with two or three lessons each week, each lasting an hour. Use these handy guided reading questions to accompany your reading of Fantastic Mr Fox 'The Shooting' (chapter 3). The questions are sorted into AF2, AF3, AF4/5 and AF6. Challenge questions have also been included for more able pupils.
