

Download Main Idea Multiple Choice Questions

Third Grade

The main idea is the most important idea in a paragraph. With this worksheet, students will read the paragraphs carefully then circle the statement that best fits the paragraph's main idea. SUMMARY. This is a tutorial on creating multiple choice questions, framed by Haladyna's heuristics for test design and Anderson & Krathwohl's update to Bloom's taxonomy. My interest in computer-gradable test questions is to support teaching and learning rather than high-stakes examination. Main Idea Worksheet 1 – Students read seven original nonfiction passages and summarize the main idea of each passage. Also, students must think of a title for each passage that relates to the main idea of the text. Suggested reading level for this text: Grade 6-10 Before beginning this lesson, be sure that you have created a number of "themed" bags, full of items that represent the supporting details to help students identify the main idea of each bag. The number of bags you create should match the number of stations you set up, including one extra for you to ...
