

Download Manual Dodge Series Trucks

The Dodge WC series was a prolific range of light 4WD and medium 6WD military utility trucks, produced by Dodge / Fargo during World War II. Together with the 1 ½ 4-ton jeeps produced by Willys and Ford, the Dodge 1 ½ 2-ton and 3 ½ 4-ton made up nearly all of the light 4WD trucks supplied to the U.S. military in WWII – with Dodge contributing some 337,500 4WD units – over half as ...The D/W series was a line of pickup trucks that was sold by Dodge from 1961 to 1993. The same basic design was retained until the 1994 introduction of a completely redesigned Ram. The D/W series shared its AD platform with the Dodge Ramcharger/Plymouth Trail Duster twins. 4x2 models were designated D, while 4x4 models were designated W.Dodge A-series Vans: A-100 and A-108. by David Zatz; thanks to Don Bunn's Plymouth Bulletin article. The first postwar Dodge vans and compact trucks were Forward Control designs, wider and higher than the Chevrolet and Ford vans, the same weight as the Chevy and lighter than the Ford. They could seat 9 passengers or provide 213 cubic feet of cargo space.1977 Plymouth and Dodge trucks and vans. Dodge's 1977 trucks were part of the progression of trucks from pure commercial vehicles to passenger car replacements; they had a wide range of convenience features, new colors, and a new grille for light duty pickups and sport utility vehicles.
