Created and maintained by the American Medical Association, the Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) code set accounts for medical, surgical, and diagnostic services. Like ICD codes, CPT codes communicate uniform information about medical services and procedures to healthcare payers. Common Physical Therapy CPT Codes. The most commonly used CPT codes for Physical Therapy are listed below. For example, the CPT code for physical therapy evaluation is 97001. The CPT code is listed on the left, the name of the code is in the middle and the description is in the right column. Tiered Physical Therapy Evaluation and Reevaluation CPT Codes. The new evaluation codes reflect 3 levels of patient presentation: low-complexity (97161), moderate-complexity (97162), and high-complexity (97163), and replace the current 97001 code. The new reevaluation code (97164) replaces the current 97002.
