

Download Ubuntu Manual Install Deb

To install a .deb file, simply Right click on the .deb file, and choose Kubuntu Package Menu-> Install Package. Alternatively, you can also install a .deb file by opening a terminal and typing: `sudo dpkg -i package_file.deb`; To uninstall a .deb file, remove it using Adept, or type: `sudo apt-get remove package_name` When you download packages for Linux Debian or Ubuntu they usually come in the .deb format and are installed automatically by your local package manager. If you download them from the internet instead of the repositiorial way however you are given the .deb file and have to deal with it yourself. But there are still times when a software we want is not available in the official package repository and we have to download the DEB package file from the official website of that software and install it on our Ubuntu/Debian operating system manually. In this article, I am going to show you how to install a DEB file on Ubuntu.
